The Village Show will be open to the Public 12 noon - 3pm. The Church of St John the Baptist will also be open from 12 noon - 3pm providing additional space if needed for exhibits, a Community Café and drop-in place. Cakes will be on sale here.

Scarecrows will populate our village for the whole weekend. A family treasure trail quiz will take place on Saturday 7th between 12noon and 3pm. Please register at the **church** (not the Community Centre) to collect a family treasure trail quiz sheet.

Village Show exhibits cannot be removed until after the public viewing and identification of winners. Between 3pm - 4pm exhibitors are invited to collect their exhibits or donate them to the Public Auction. Any exhibits not collected will be considered to be donated.

## Sunday 8th September

There will be an auction of donated items held in the Marquee at The White Horse Inn commencing 5pm. Children are welcome. The winners of the Scarecrow Festival will be announced, together with Best In Show and the Young Persons Cup.

**The Village Show** is an old tradition that enables neighbours and friends to come together and show what they have been working on, growing, and making. We hope there is a category for everyone!

Any number of exhibits may be entered in a class. There are 3 points for 1<sup>st</sup> Place, 2 points for 2<sup>nd</sup> Place and 1 point for 3<sup>rd</sup> Place. The person with the highest marks is awarded the Misson Community Association Cup and holds it for the year.

### Things you need to know

1. The Village Show is open to anyone resident in the parish of Misson or a regular attendee of a village group.
2. All exhibits must be the original work of the exhibitor and a product of their own time and talent. No entry should be bought or borrowed.
3. All flowers, plants, and produce should be grown by the exhibitor from seed, cutting, bulb or plug.
4. Children are eligible to enter all Classes. Section 6 is open to young people only.
5. Judging will take place behind closed doors and the decisions of the Judges are final.
6. Please note : the organisers will endeavour to take care of exhibits while on the show tables but cannot be responsible for any loss or damage to any exhibit.
7. Cost of entries are as follows :  
Adult – 50p per Class entered  
Children – 20p per Class entered

- Class 9 Longest runner bean
- Class 10 3 beetroot on a plate
- Class 11 Heaviest marrow
- Class 12 3 dessert apples on a plate
- Class 13 3 cooking apples on a plate
- Class 14 Heaviest pumpkin
- Class 15 Three bunches of herbs in a container, tied and named
- Class 16 A wonky vegetable – the unusual one of your crop

- Class 18 An arrangement of sweet peas
- Class 19 One rose judged for perfume

- Class 22 Mixed garden flowers – max 5 varieties, two stems from each



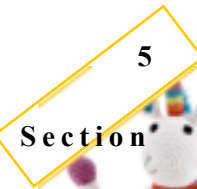
